

Q-PrEP – The Hague Workshop

Important: Bring a form of ID (for example a passport, identification card or EU driver license) so that you can enter the building.

How to get there:

By public transport

From Schiphol Airport, trains depart frequently towards The Hague Central station. Depending on the train, the journey will take between 33 and 45 minutes. It's recommended to take the 'intercity' train, which is quicker than the 'sprinter' train.

If you travel by Eurostar from Belgium or France, please change to the local train from Rotterdam Central Station. From Rotterdam, both 'intercity' and 'sprinter' trains depart frequently to The Hague Central Station.

When you arrive at The Hague Central Station, you can reach the ministry on foot (3 to 5 minutes). Exit the station at platform 1 and follow the pedestrian route under the former Ministry of VROM towards the city centre. On your left, you will see the new BZK and JenV building. The main entrance to the new building is accessible via the garden on the Turfmarkt.

By bicycle

The entrance to the bicycle parking is on the side of the Turfmarkt 147 building at Zwarteweg 48. With your back to Central Station, this is the street to the left across the bridge. The parking facility is located in the basement and can be reached via the ramp. The facility is accessible during the building's opening hours from 06:45 to 19:30. By holding your hand in front of the red illuminated button, the door opens automatically.

By car

From the motorway, follow the signs for The Hague-Voorburg from the Prins Clausplein. You will enter The Hague via the Utrechtse Baan. Take exit 2-'Centrum' there. At the traffic lights, turn left over the viaduct. Drive under the green 'Terminal Noord' building and follow the signs for 'parking Spui/Turfmarkt'. You will then go through a tunnel to the public Turfmarkt parking garage (not free).

Where to stay:

It's recommended to stay in or close to the city center of The Hague. The program will take place in this area. If you stay in a different location, please look into easy ways to get to the venue, like using close-by bus or tram stop. There is plenty of choice in hotels in different price ranges. We don't offer any deals with local hotels.
